The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is the biggest change in disability support and funding in Australian history and aims to give people with a disability and their carers access to services and funds to put them in control of their own future.

What is the NDIS and how does it work?

The purpose of the NDIS is to provide a range of individualised support services to Australians living with a lifelong disability. The NDIS aims to take a flexible and whole-of-life approach to working with participants, their families and carers.

Each participant has an individualised plan and once a person is accepted to the NDIS, they will continue to receive services through the scheme throughout their lifetime to help them to pursue their goals and aspirations and participate in daily life.

Do I qualify for the NDIS?

To access the NDIS you must live in an area where the NDIS is available, be under 65 years of age, an Australian citizen or resident or permanent visa holder, and meet the disability or early intervention requirements. If you are unsure whether you meet these requirements, an access checklist is available on the NDIS website – ndis.gov.au.

What support can I get from the NDIS?

The life of each person with a disability is different, so the level and type of NDIS support received will be different for everybody.

NDIS Funding is broken up in three budgets or support purposes – core, capital and capacity building. You may have budget in just one category or across all three. The funding in each category is based on what's reasonable and necessary to help you achieve your goals.



Core supports: These supports help you with everyday activities. This budget is flexible and can be used across the four support categories of assistance with daily life, consumables, assistance with social and community participation, and transport.

Capacity Building supports: These supports help you build independence and skills to reach long-term goals. Unlike core supports, your capacity building budget is allocated for particular supports and cannot be moved to other categories.

Capital supports: This budget covers particular equipment, assistive technology and home or vehicle modifications.
